Mountain Terrain

- Through the varied landscapes of our spiritual journey, God is seeking to cultivate in us a deepening companionship and a maturing love. Thus he leads us through the deserts, up the mountains and into the cloud
- 2. **The Desert**: emptiness, dryness, and death. God leads us into the desert that we might lose *our way* in order to find *the way*
- 3. <u>The Mountains</u>: vertical edges, looking up, answering the call to climb, gaining new perspectives
 - a. Mountain terrain is the spirituality of desire (Psalm 42:1-2)
 - b. Mountain terrain is the spirituality of discovery (Phil. 3:12-14)
 - c. Mountain terrain is the spirituality that ascends (Rom. 8:18-21)
- 4. The two most powerful mountains in Scripture:
 - a. Mount Sinai (Exodus 24, 33 and 34): mystery
 - b. Mount Tabor (Matt. 17; Mark 9): manifestation
- 5. Clarity and mystery need each other. They continually challenge and renew one another
- 6. One of the vital lessons of scriptural mountains is that we must always desire but never demand
- 7. Head for the mountains, seek God, don't ever turn back!
