

Prophetic life

Acts 2:17-21 (TPT) 'This is what I will do in the last days —I will pour out my Spirit on everybody and cause your sons and daughters to prophesy, and your young men will see visions, and your old men will experience dreams from God.¹⁸ The Holy Spirit will come upon all my servants, men and women alike, and they will prophesy.¹⁹ I will reveal startling signs and wonders in the sky above and mighty miracles on the earth below. Blood and fire and pillars of clouds will appear.²⁰ For the sun will be turned dark and the moon blood-red before that great and awesome appearance of the day of the Lord.²¹ But everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'"

Acts 2:17-18 (AMPC) And it shall come to pass in the last days, God declares, that I will pour out of My Spirit upon all mankind, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy [telling forth the divine counsels] and your young men shall see visions (divinely granted appearances), and your old men shall dream [divinely suggested] dreams.
¹⁸ Yes, and on My menservants also and on My maidservants in those days I will pour out of My Spirit, and they shall prophesy [telling forth the divine counsels and predicting future events] pertaining especially to God's kingdom].
