#### The development of prophetic ministry

- 1. Prophecy definitions
  - a. Hebrew: to flow forth, to bubble forth like a fountain, to spring forth
  - b. Greek: to speak for another; speaking for the mind and counsel of God
  - c. Modern: the ability to discern the revelation of God
