Fourteen Ways God Speaks to Us

God is a speaking being. He identifies himself as "the Word" (John 1:1). What is a "word?" A word is a means of communication. In this verse, God reveals that part of his basic nature is to communicate. He speaks. In John 10, Jesus said, that his sheep "hear his voice" and he calls them by name. He tells us in verse four, that his "sheep follow him because they know his voice."

God communicates with the people he has created. He intends for us to hear his life-giving voice. The Bible reveals at least 14 ways that God communicates with us as human beings. As you study these, I pray that you will become more aware of his presence and more attuned to his voice.
