- 1. The Psalms shape our understanding of:
 - a. Reality
 - b. Humanity
 - c. Our perception of God
- 2. The Psalms serve as a spiritual root system
- 3. God created us to be "people poems"
- 4. Psalms invites us to stand at the intersection of time and eternity
- 5. Psalms welcomes us to inhabit the junction of heaven and earth
- 6. Psalms teaches us to live at the interchange of matter and spirit
- 7. We are the knot which ties heaven and earth together

8. Psalms provides for us:

- a. A sustained current of revelation
- b. Spiritual root system
- c. A backdrop for our humanity
- d. Backbone for living God's truth
- e. Access to faith
- f. Grounding in God's family
- g. Connection to the "communion of the saints"

9. The Psalms:

- b. Equip us to serve as servants of God
- c. Inspire us to worship as worshipers of God
