On Campus Volunteer Opportunities

- ❖ **Bus Buddy (first 2 days of school only):** Ride the bus home with students to assist driver
- ❖ **Pre-K, Kinder, 1st Grade Classroom Helper (first day of school only short training required):** Assist teachers with getting students to their classes, lunch, and with classroom activities.
- ❖ **Library Helper:** Shelve books in the library; Help with Book Fairs
- ❖ **Help sort snacks for holiday parties.** (2 times during the year)
- ❖ **Mentor:** (30 minutes a week)/District training required: Play games, complete puzzles, make a craft, read a book, help with homework, whatever you would like to do to make a difference.
- ❖ **Help Music Teacher:** Assist with music practices/programs
- ❖ **Help with Vision/Hearing screening**
- ❖ **Help Serve at Open House**
- ❖ **Help with Picture Days**

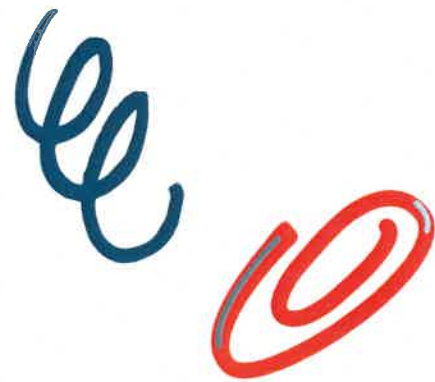
