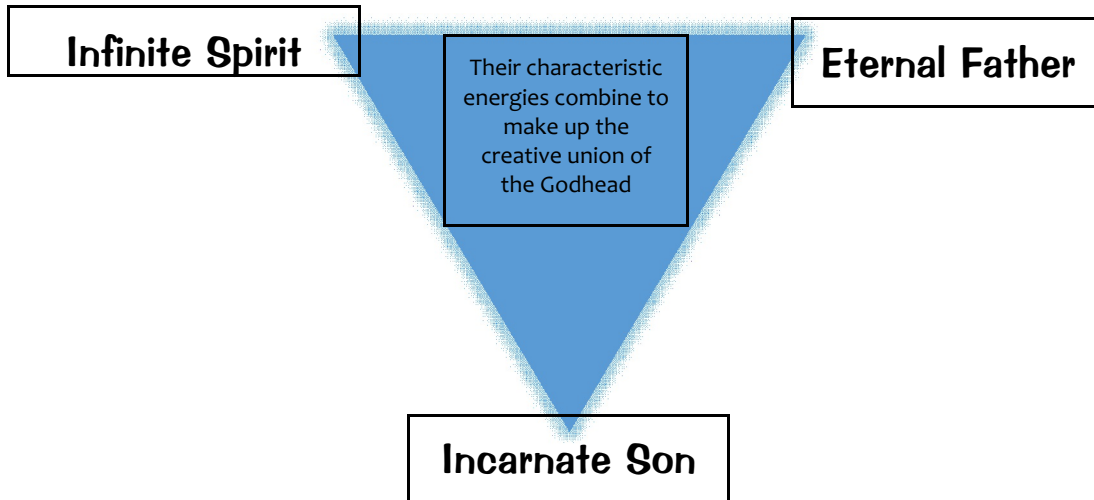

Trinity must remain intact

Christ must remain as the foundation, the focus, and the finish.

Heb. 12:2 We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith.* NLT (* Or Jesus, the originator and perfecter of our faith.)

1. Foundation

1 Cor. 3:11 For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have—Jesus Christ. NLT

2. Focus

Heb. 12:1-2 And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. 2 We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion....NLT

3. Finish

Heb. 12:2-3 Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, on whom our faith depends from beginning to end.
