## Seeing the Invisible

- 1. There are two kinds of people in the world:
  - a. Those who believe in God
  - b. Those who believe in something else
- 2. Two causalogical options:
  - a. Either put your faith in a god of random chance
  - b. Or put your faith in the God of intelligent design
  - c. **Heb. 11:3** "By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command..."
- 3. It takes faith to believe in a God of intelligent design
  - a. **Heb. 11:6** "Without faith it is impossible to please God, for he who comes to God must believe that he is and that he is a rewarder of those who earnestly seek him."
  - b. It is a mistake to think that religion involves faith and science doesn't
  - c. Everybody puts their faith in something they can't prove
- 4. We take constants for granted
  - a. John Donne, "There is nothing that God hath established in the constant course of Nature, and which therefore is done every day, but would seem a miracle, and [stir] admiration, if it were done but once."
  - b. We are surrounded by miracles; we just take them for granted
- 5. Let there be light
  - a. **Gen. 1:3** "And God said, 'Let there be light.' And there was light."
  - b. Physics is primarily a study of what we can't see
  - c. What we see isn't light; we see reflected light
  - d. **Job 38:19-20** God asks Job, "Where does the light come from, and where does the darkness go? <sup>20</sup> Can you take it to its home? Do you know how to get there?"

- 6. Light is:
  - a. Invisible
  - b. Pervasive
  - c. Elusive
  - d. Fast
- 7. **Heb. 11:3** "By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible."
  - a. The human eye is only able to respond to light waves that are between .00004 and .00007 centimeters long.
  - b. Therefore, we can't see x-rays, gamma rays, ultraviolet rays, radio waves, or micro waves.
- 8. The Holy Spirit gives us "extra-sensory" perception
  - a. **1 Cor. 2:9** "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived of what God has prepared for those who love him."
  - b. 1 Cor. 2:10 "But God has revealed them to us by his Spirit."
  - c. **1 Cor. 2:14** "The natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them..."
  - d. **2 Cor. 4:18** "So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal."
- 9. Faith sees the invisible
  - a. Faith anchors our lives in eternity
  - b. Faith grounds us in wisdom beyond the world's ways
  - c. Faith illumines values deeper than our cultural vision
  - d. Faith allows us to commune with a Presence that the world cannot see
  - e. Faith is as essential to the spiritual realm as light is to the material realm
- 10. Light is:
  - a. The basis of all life
  - b. The basis of communication
  - c. The basis of health
  - d. The basis of time and space

- 11. God is Light and Jesus is the Lamp
  - a. **1 John 1:5** "This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all."
  - b. I believe that our resurrection bodies will have increased abilities and heightened senses, allowing us to experience much more of God's creation
  - c. Please meditate on Rev. 21:1-7, 10-12, 21-27
  - d. **Rev. 21:23** "The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp."
- 12. The God who created you wants to spend eternity with you. But you have to make reservations!
  - a. Believer, it is our mission to bring others into faith in Christ, that all of us together might make the journey into the Light!
