Friend,

We are so excited that you have chosen to participate in this year's Scripture memory program. I pray that you will experience the joy of knowing God more as you hide His Word in your heart.

This year's program is made up of five Scripture memory levels. You may memorize at your own pace, but the levels must be completed in order.

How the program works:

Memorize and recite each verse and its scripture reference in level 1 to our Bible Coach. You may recite one verse at a time until you complete all the verses in that level. All Bible memory work must be recited completely by memory, in order, with no mistakes. Once you have completed level 1, you may begin working on level 2. Most verses in this book are from the New International Version (NIV). If you memorize the verse in a different version of the Bible than the one listed in this book, you may bring that Bible version to the Bible Memory Coach and recite the verse in the alternate version.

Rewards:

A. You will earn three Honor Awards for each memory verse and its scriptural reference that you accurately recite to the Bible Memory coach. These Honor Awards may be used to purchase prizes from our prize carts.

B. When you complete a level, you will earn a gift card.

Levels 1 and 2: \$5 gift card

Levels 3 and 4: \$10 gift card

Level 5: \$25 gift card and a trophy

C. Kids earn an invitation to a special ice cream party in June when they complete Level 1 or higher.
